Subject: Hotel/Motel Safety While Traveling



Our society continues to grow more mobile. Travelers often become crime targets. Here are a few tips to consider when traveling.

- 1. Never answer the room door at a hotel/motel without verifying exactly who it is. If the person claims to be an employee of the hotel/motel, make them wait and call the front desk and ask if someone from the hotel/motel staff is supposed to have access to your rook and why.
- 2. If you leave your room for any reason, always make sure that the door securely locks behind you.
- 3. When returning to your hotel/motel room, always use the main entrance for the facility.
- 4. Be observant and look around before you enter the parking lot and again before you exit your vehicle.
- 5. Always close the door securely when you are in your room and use all locking devices provided.
- 6. Don't needlessly display guest room keys in public or carelessly leave them on restaurant tables, at the swimming pool or any place where they can easily be stolen.
- 7. Don't draw attention to yourself by displaying large amounts of cash or expensive jewelry.
- 8. Never invite a stranger to your room.
- 9. Place all valuables in the hotel/motel room safe or office safety deposit box.
- 10. Never leave valuables in your vehicle.
- 11. Check to see that any sliding glass door, windows, and any connecting doors are securely locked.
- 12. If you see any suspicious activity report it immediately to the management or local law enforcement if needed.
